If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

SERVICE OPTIONS NON-DECLINABLE BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service, available 24 hours a day; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; shelter of remains for the first 24 hours; crematory fee; and local transportation to the crematory. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations). \$2,645

The charge for direct cremation includes transfer of remains to funeral home, local transportation to the crematory, necessary authorizations and basic services of staff, and crematory fee. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to cremation. Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation contaier is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are made of composition materials.
